It is rare that we are able to help a wonderful group of people to start an enterprise so that they can support themselves and escape poverty. Many items are needed to start a Geese Farm.

**SOME COSTS OF THE PROJECT:
300 young geese.... \$ 3600**

**FEED FOR GEESE:
Corn for 15 Days..... \$ 330
Corn for 6 months..... \$ 3960
Carrots for 6 months \$ 432**

OTHER EXPENSES:

Antibiotics.....	\$ 540
Materials for Corral.....	\$ 160
Cement for Pond.....	\$ 70
Transportation of Geese	\$ 50
Transportation of Eggs to Market	\$ 174
Refrigeration.....	\$ 150
Water for Pond.....	\$ 5

For example a donation of \$20 US will purchase one goose and food for 3 months.
